Concept:

Create a xeriscaped garden setting with four seasons of interest that can be enjoyed from inside the building, sitting at the benches and entering the lobby. While changing the grade to daylight the buried windows, a new slope will be created that will alleviate drainage issues utilizing a dry creek system woven among existing trees. Boulders, foliage textures, a natural progression of flower and leaf colors combine to add excitement and variety with low maintenance materials that change the entrance from boring to memorable as visitors and employees will probably see hummingbirds and butterflies in the summer.



Remove diseased and damaged trees and shrubs.


Reduce the mulch on the declining Maple to reinvigorate growth.
